Changemaker Scholarship Programme

1. Scholarship Details

Name of the Scholarship:

Changemaker Scholarship

TF will offer two (2) scholarships to EQZE, subject to the following conditions:

1. The student must be **unconditionally admitted** to the study programme at EQZE.
2. Students must demonstrate **sufficient English proficiency** to participate successfully in the programme.
3. The student must embody a **changemaker's vision** – individuals with a clear intent to contribute meaningfully to society, supported by a broad plan or aspiration to achieve this goal.

Additionally, students must come from one or more of the following backgrounds:

1. Limited access to financial, educational, social, or health resources.
2. Refugee or newcomer status.
3. First-generation university students.
4. Part of the LGBTQI+ community facing personal safety concerns due to their identity.

Scholarship Duration:

The scholarship will cover **10 months**, from **September 2026 to June 2027**.



2. Scholar Journey and Expectations

Our Vision:

We aim to support scholars in their journey of personal and professional growth, evolving them further in their **identity as changemakers** — individuals equipped to lead positive social impact in their communities and beyond.

Each Changemaker Scholar will participate in the following key components, forming the **Scholar Journey**:

- 1. Aspire Series:**
A curated series of **10 workshops** focused on **personal growth, leadership, and social impact**.
Scholars will select **any 4 workshops** that best align with their interests and developmental needs.
- 2. Mentorship:**
Each scholar will be **paired with a mentor** from the TSH community. Pairings are based on the scholar's goals and areas of growth.
This **4-month mentorship programme** is designed to foster meaningful connections and includes **6–8 meetings** between mentor and mentee.
- 3. Scholar Circles (in partnership with The School for Moral Ambition):**
Scholars will participate in a **peer-to-peer learning framework** that encourages reflection and growth in their identity as changemakers.
These sessions are designed to deepen self-awareness, strengthen moral clarity, and nurture community-driven leadership.
- 4. Community Engagement:**
Scholars will engage in **community events, gatherings, and a graduation ceremony** that bring together local and global members of the Changemaker community.
This component reinforces belonging, collaboration, and shared purpose.

Overall Commitment:

Across all activities, scholars are expected to dedicate approximately **30 hours** over the academic year to their development journey.



3. Changemaker Scholarship Details

The **Changemaker Scholarship Programme (the "Programme")** includes the following components:

1. Accommodation and Development:

The Foundation offers a **room at The Student Hotel (TSH)** for the full term, free of charge. The room includes a private bathroom, study desk, TV, high-speed Wi-Fi, linen, towels, cleaning, and access to a fully equipped shared kitchen (including cutlery and utensils).

Students will also have access to **on-site laundry, coworking spaces, gym access, free bike sharing, and a comprehensive skills and wellbeing programme.**

Additionally, scholars will participate in an **upskilling programme of 5 sessions** on themes like self-awareness, storytelling, and well-being.

2. Personal Growth:

Each student will go through a journey as outlined in the section before.

3. Network and Collaboration:

Students may participate in social activities organized at their hotel and, upon completion, will gain **membership in the TSH Changemaker Network** — connecting them to a broader community of alumni and stakeholders.
